- Preparation of café areas.
- To record all food safety temperatures on relevant monitoring forms, daily.
- To stock the chiller cabinet and complete stock control sheet, daily.
- Help in the preparation of events and buffets for YMCA related activities.
- To ensure the kitchen is maintained to a high level by following a regular cleaning schedule.
