Job Description

As a volunteer within the Bradbury Café at the YMCA, you will work alongside members of our Catering Team, and work within all aspects of a busy onsite café. The Bradbury Café, based at our main site on Freeman Street in Grimsby offers meals, snacks and refreshments from 9.00am – 3.00pm Monday to Friday.

Key Responsibilities:

Meeting and Greeting both residential and external customers. Taking food and drinks orders and operating the till when required. Assisting in the set up of the main Café area and conferencing rooms. Assist in the preparation of food for events and buffets. Ensuring you work to a safe standard of food handling. Ability to maintain a high standard of cleanliness within the Kitchen Area.

Requirements:

Ability to use own initiative and work with other volunteers. Practical skills and a basic knowledge of food handling. Commitment to volunteer a few hours each month on a regular basis or as needed. Must be 18 years or older.

Meeting new people and being part of a friendly and supportive team at YMCA Humber. Regular supervision with a line manager to discuss progress and areas of development.
